



# Do You Have Chronic Hepatitis D?

Doctors at the National Institutes of Health (NIH) seek people 18 years of age and older, who have been diagnosed with chronic hepatitis D, to participate in a research study at the Clinical Center. The purpose of this study is to find out if treatment with lonafarnib and ritonavir is safe and effective.

All study-related tests and procedures are provided at no cost to the study participant.

## **Study information:**

- Screening with a medical history, physical exams, and blood tests
- Study duration is 48 weeks, which includes a 3-day inpatient stay and outpatient visits for the duration of the study
- 24 weeks of treatment with lonafarnib and ritonavir or 12 weeks of placebo and then 12 weeks of lonafarnib and ritonavir; then 24 weeks of follow-up as an outpatient

**Location:** The NIH Clinical Center, America's research hospital, is located on the Metro red line (Medical Center stop) in Bethesda, Maryland.
