



## *Volunteers with Rheumatoid Arthritis Needed*

**NIH...Turning Discovery Into Health®**

Researchers at the National Institutes of Health (NIH) seek volunteers who have rheumatoid arthritis (RA) that is well controlled on a tumor necrosis factor (TNF) inhibitor such as Enbrel®, Humira®, or Remicaide®. Doctors want to know if patients with RA in remission will stay in remission if they discontinue their TNF inhibitor.

### **About the study:**

- ▶ Participants will receive either their current medications or placebo for 11 months
- ▶ Study visits occur every 2-3 months or sooner if your symptoms return
- ▶ There is no charge for medications, tests, and procedures
- ▶ Compensation will be provided

### **You may participate in this study if:**

- ▶ You are at least 18 years of age and have RA that is well-controlled on a TNF inhibitor
