

Researchers at the National Institutes of Health (NIH) Clinical Center are seeking healthy children for a study of growth and health behaviors.

Purpose: To better understand growth in children and adolescents.

Who: Healthy boys and girls between the ages of 8 and 17 years old.

What: During the study, boys and girls will have a physical examination, fill out

questionnaires, do a fitness test, have a hand x-ray, eat a meal, and give urine and blood samples. Parents/guardians will be informed about

possible procedures and must give consent for participation.

Compensation is provided.

Where: The study takes place at the NIH Clinical Center in Bethesda, Maryland.

Time required: Two screening visits. If eligible, boys and girls will be invited to

participate in three additional studies visits and be seen

once a year for the next six years.
