


INFANTS NEEDED FOR RESEARCH STUDY

Researchers at the National Institute of Child Health and Human Development are seeking infants age 9-12 months for a study of imitation, brain activity, and social communication.



What will my baby do?

Infants will complete play-based activities while wearing a cap which contains sensors measuring their brain activity. This cap was specifically designed for use with infants, as it can be used to comfortably measure their brain activation while they respond to stimuli.
