

SUMMER INTERNSHIP PROGRAM

Eight-week, paid research opportunities for high school, college, graduate, and health professional students

POSTBACCALURATE IRTA PROGRAM

One-to-two year research program for recent college graduates taking a gap year before enrolling in graduate or professional school

CLINICAL AND TRANSLATIONAL RESEARCH COURSE FOR PHD STUDENTS

Two-week intensive program for doctoral students pursuing a Ph.D. in the basic sciences



MEDICAL RESEARCH SCHOLARS PROGRAM

One year program for medical, dental, veterinary students interested in basic, clinical, or translational research

CLINICAL ELECTIVES PROGRAM

Four- to twelve-week elective specialty or subspecialty rotations for senior year medical and dental students. Electives also available for dually enrolled M.D. or D.O./Ph.D students

CORE CURRICULUM IN CLINICAL RESEARCH

Three courses available via distance learning: Ethical and Regulatory Aspects of Clinical Research, Introduction to the Principles and Practice of Clinical Research, and Principles of Clinical Research



GRADUATE MEDICAL EDUCATION

ACGME-accredited and other subspecialty or translational medicine fellowship programs for physicians-in-training

RESIDENT ELECTIVE PROGRAM

Four- to eight-week clinical rotations for physicians-in-training to learn about therapies and management of patients enrolled in investigational protocols

SABBATICAL IN CLINICAL RESEARCH MANAGEMENT

Three-week to six month customized educational experience for mid-career research administrators and clinical investigators
